**a)** Appeal lodged – Limestone Hotel, Main Road, West Lulworth, BH20 5RL: An appeal against the refusal of a planning application to erect a detached (semi portable) ancillary letting room & terrace.

**Resolved** that the Parish Council object for the same reasons as the planning application and that it will be out of character with the Conservation Area, insufficient screening and visible from the surrounding area.

**b)** 6/2020/0416 Lulworth Cove Inn, Main Road, West Lulworth, BH20 5RQ: Redecoration of the exterior including a mural and sign written inn name and illuminated sign written inn name.

**Resolved** that the Parish Council object due to the impact on the character of the Conservation Area.
