Minutes

20/21/094

The minutes from Monday 7 December 2020 were agreed as an accurate representation of the meeting and duly signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising from The Previous Minutes

20/21/095

There were no matters arising from the last minutes.

Report from Dorset Council Ward Member

20/21/096

Dorset Councillor reports were not available at the meeting and would be resent by the Clerk.

Planning Applications/ Updates on Previous Applications

20/21/097

a) 6/2020/0606 West Lulworth C of E Primary School, School Lane, West Lulworth, BH20 5SA: Application for non-material amendment of PP 6/2018/0653 to remove one chimney from the old school building. The chimney was thought to have already been removed.

Resolved that the Parish Council object to the application due to the aesthetic on the street scene being adversely affected and it would undermine the AONB status.

b) 6/2020/0505 Binford Range, Lulworth Camp, West Lulworth, BH20 5QS: Application to erect a 25m telecommunications mast together with 4 cabinets, compound fence, 2 transmission dishes and ancillary development.

It was pointed out that the projected range only covered the Army Camp and not West Lulworth village and the technological benefits were not demonstrated for the area. Some councillors felt the introduction of 5G to the area would be beneficial for local people.

Councillors voted - four objected and two were in favour of the proposal.

Resolved that the Parish Council object to the application due to the height being three times the height of the surrounding trees and it would therefore be out of keeping with the surrounding area which does not have high infrastructure.

c) It was agreed that outstanding enforcement issues should be resent to Dorset Council for action.

Tree Works Applications / Updates on Previous Applications

20/21/098

There were no new tree works applications.

Finance

20/21/099

a) It was agreed that the following were recommended for approval for payment:

Payments proposed totalling	£1092.51
Interest received (December)	£0.04

b) The precept for 2021/22 was discussed. The tax base had been made available and the Clerk presented a draft budget for the forthcoming year that showed predicted annual costs including a Chairman's Allowance with the proviso that any payments should be agreed by full Council.

Resolved that the precept was set at a 5% annual increase (£3.10 annual increase on the previous year).

c) A donation to Purbeck CAB was considered.

Resolved that £200.00 was given to Purbeck CAB.

d) The Clerk presented a report on membership of the SLCC.

Resolved that membership of SLCC, payment for the practitioners' conference and cost of the latest Local Council Administration book was approved.

New Items for Discussion or Report

20/21/100

a) Activities for children and teenagers within West Lulworth was discussed. Regular provision of a youth group was considered and specific areas for play.

It was agreed that further information is required on current provision and the requirement within the parish.

b) A response to the Purbeck Local Plan Main Modifications Consultation was discussed. There were concern about the change of words from "up to 470" to "around 470" with no definition of the term "around". There was concern over the lack of provision for genuinely affordable housing.

ACTION: A response to be submitted, including comments on the small sites policy to be submitted.

c) A report on SID (Speed Indicator Device) was distributed. It was agreed that a 20mph speed limit within the village would be a better way to alleviate some traffic concerns.

d) It was agreed that a response to the DAPTC Area Committee review would be submitted by Cllr Jackson.

e) It was agreed that a response to the Dorset Council Climate and Ecology Strategy would be submitted by Cllr Davey.

f) The West Lulworth operational plan had been presented to Cllrs Davey, Jackson and Wilson at a recent liaison meeting.

A one-way bypass road from Burngate to Durdle Door was discussed.

ACTION: Cllr Wilson to respond to the Operational Plan and circulate.

Ongoing Actions

The litter bin at the MUGA had still not been emptied. It had been reported online then reported again via telephone. A direct email had now been sent to the management at the Wareham depot and a response was awaited.
